

## Elveden Church Some Notes

The bell tower of Elveden Church was built in 1922 as a memorial to the wife of the first Earl Iveagh. Caroe was the architect, and he installed eight bells, dedicated to Mary, Gabriel, Edmund, Andrew, Patrick, Christ, God the Father, and the King. The excellent guidebook recalls that his intention was for the bells to be *cast to maintain the hum and tap tones of the renowned ancient Suffolk bells of Lavenham... thus the true bell music of the old type is maintained.*
